## Parks canada banff national park trail report

Some of the absolute best hiking trails found anywhere in the United States are located in America's national parks, these iconic destinations, scattered throughout the country, often have miles of trails to hike, giving hikers a bragging-worthy experience to share with friends and family. But with so many tracks to choose from, it can be difficult to choose which ones are worth your time and effort. Thankfully, we have had some expertise in this area and can recommend some tracks that will not disappoint. With this in mind, these are our top ten national park hikes that every traveler should have on his or her bucket list. 01 of 10 Whit Richardson/Getty Images Grand Canyon National Park in Arizona is home to one of the most classic hikes in all of North America. The 12-mile round-trip walk along the Bright Angel Trail provides stunning views of the canyon and the surrounding landscape, which are among the most iconic and well-known in the world. The hike can be a strenuous one at times, but it's also a very rewarding one as well. No matter when you go, always bring plenty of water, staying hydrated can be a constant struggle in the always dry and often warm environment. 02 of 10 Simon Dannhauer/Getty Images Utah's Bryce Canyon National Park offers some of the most unique landscapes you'll find anywhere, and one of the best trails to explore that environment on is the 3-mile-long Navajo Loop. From Sunset Point and run out to a place called the main amphitheater, this trail takes hikers past some of the more scenic elements throughout the park. One of the best hiking routes there is the Sargent Mountain Loop, a 5.5-mile round-trip walk that takes visitors to the top of the 1,373-foot peak from which it originated its name. Sargent Mountain is one of the most important landmarks found inside the park and at the top you will be treated to outstanding views of the Acadia coast, as well as the lush forests of spruce and spruce that are common throughout the area. 4 of 10 Brent Winebrenner/Getty Images When it comes to sheer beauty, few hiking routes around the world can match California's John Muir Trail, which passes through parts of Yosemite, Kings Canyon and Sequoia National Parks along its 211-mile route. The route, which is actually part of the much larger Pacific Crest Trail, offers many day hikes or can be tackled end-to-end for a real backcountry adventure. Breathtaking vistas, crystal clear currents and peaceful solitude are the norm here as backpackers find their way through the High Sierra Mountains. This is a truly remote, rugged and challenging walk, so be sure to be well prepared before you head out. Continue 5 out of 10 below. 05 of 10 TripSavvy/Alisha McDarris Montana is a state filled with beautiful scenery, but Glacier National Park just can hold the crown for the most scenic spot for them all. To get a true look at what this park has to offer, take a stroll along the 11-mile round-trip Grinnell Glacier Trail, which takes hikers out to a view that provides spectacular views of some of the park's namesake features. This track is only open from July to September, but it is a can not miss walk during the summer months when the weather is at its absolute best. 06 of 10 Pierre Leclerc Photography/Getty Images At just 3 miles in length, the Hawksbill Loop Trail in Virginia's Shenandoah National Park may not seem very long, but it packs lots of punch. The route wanders along part of the legendary Appalachian Trail en route to the top of Hawksbill—the highest point of the park at just over 4,000 feet in height. Along the way, hikers will likely spot plenty of wildlife as they hike upward toward the top. Once there, they will discover a stone platform that offers views of thick forests and rolling hills that stretch all the way to the horizon. 07 of 10 TripSavvy / Jess Macdonald California's Yosemite National Park is famous for its spectacular waterfalls, which are numerous and impressive. No one is more awe inspiring than Yosemite Falls though, which has the distinction of being the highest in North America. If you're up for a challenging hike, taking the trail to the top of the falls is a great way to stretch your legs. You'll climb more than 2,700 feet in just 3.5 miles, but the reward is a stunning view of Yosemite Creek as it tumbles over the mountain face right at your feet. The view of the surrounding landscapes isn't bad either, so don't be surprised if they take your breath away. 08 of 10 Sierralara/ Getty Images For a hike unlike any other, leave the traditional dirt trails behind and take a walk through Zion Narrows in Zion National Park located in Utah. The route follows a series of slot canyons through the backcountry, with the official route running about 16 miles in round trip length. There are many offshoots to be explored though and it can be fun to indulge your sense of exploration and adventure. Just be sure you know how to navigate, because the place can feel like a maze sometimes. The Narrows consists of a series of twisted aisles like cobwebs across the landscape, waving those who love to get lost in the backcountry. Be sure to bring a pair of water shoes or sports sandals for this hike, as the canyon floor is often covered by a rushing river. Continue to 9 of 10 below. 09 of 10 Posnow/Getty Images Isle Royal National Park is unique in that the entire preserve is found on an isolated island in the middle of Lake Superior in Michigan. Just to get there, hikers must first catch a daily ferry that will shuttle them to the remote location. Ferry drops hikers off at the start of 40 miles Ridge Trail, which runs west to east through the wild center of the national park. Surprisingly, there are plenty of wildlife to discover at the Isle Royal, including moose, deer and wolves, so keep your eyes peeled like you. The hike is a scenic one too, often offering excellent views of the Lake Superior shoreline along the way. This is a spectacular walk through a national park that most people don't even know exists, let alone consider visiting. Still, the track can get crowded during the busy season, although it never detracts from the experience. 10 out of 10 TripSavvy/Alisha McDarris Texas is well known for its arid desert landscapes to the west, thick forests to the east, and rolling hill land in the center. But did you know that it is also home to a mountain that stands more than 8750 meters in height? The Guadalupe Peak Trail, located in Guadalupe Mountains National Park, winds its way to the top of that mountain, adding more than 3,000 feet of vertical gain — spread over 8.4 miles — along the way. At the top, hikers discover a view the size of Texas itself, with dramatic vistas to be seen in all directions. It's a strenuous hike, but a surprisingly good one, with some great payoffs along the way. Welcome!
